

# **Library Corner**


The library is getting Close to finishing some of the read aloud novels for each class, and working on finding



#### Dear Friends:

Soon we will be celebrating the birth of our Lord. The words from St. Luke's gospel which will be proclaimed on Christmas Eve assure us that the birth of Jesus means "glory to God in the highest" and "on earth peace among those on whom he favors!" Most people would not question that Christ's birth gave glory to God in the highest, but we may wonder about peace on earth.
