Advent 2021 - Mary's Journey

Theotokos is a term used primarily in the East for Our Lady,

literally meaning "God bearer." The theological reality implied in the name is that Mary truly carried in her womb, and then gave birth to the Incarnation, God in human form. So, we in the West usually translate the word into "Mother of God."

However, let's look at the word for it's more literal meaning. Mary bore Jesus, that is carried Him inside herself, until she gave birth to Him in a manger. The emphasis is not only on the birth, but also the actual time of pregnancy. For 9 months, all who came into contact with her were in the real presence of the Divine. Recall her visit to see her cousin, Elizabeth. The child in Elizabeth's womb, John the Baptist, started leaping with joy to be in the presence of God in Mary's womb.

Mary serves as an example to us on how to live holy lives. But, we are also called to be "God-bearers." Because of her fiat, her saying yes to God's plan of salvation, Jesus Christ entered the world. He remains with us, most notably in the sacrament of Eucharist. When we go forth from Mass, we bear God within us, taking Him into the world. All that come into contact with us are in the real presence of the Divine.

All this is possible because Mary totally gave herself over to God. As good stewards, we are called to do the same. When we say yes, we then receive Jesus in the sacraments. We then carry Him into a world that needs the presence of the Divine more than ever. Our calendar year begins with a reminder of this reality, the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. A good resolution for this New Year is to try hard to bring God to others, just as Mary did for us.
