2023 - New Year's Challenge - Slow Down

Pope Francis this year challenges us to look carefully at the lessons taught to us by the shepherds in the nativity story. He tells us the shepherds did two very important things, they went and they saw Christ. These actions were simple, but not always easy. They easily could have got caught up with their work and their lifestyle which demands so much time. As we ask ourselves what is God calling us to do this year, perhaps these words of Pope Francis might provide us inspiration. The following reflection is taken from Pope Francis' January 1st homily.



"How many times, in our busy lives, do we fail to stop, even for a moment, to be close to the Lord and to hear his word, to say a prayer, to adore and praise him. We do the same thing with others: caught up in our own affairs or in getting ahead, we have no time to listen to our wife, our husband, to talk with our children, to ask them about *how they really are*, and not simply about their studies or their health. And how good it is for us to take time and listen to the elderly, to our grandfathers and grandmothers, in order to remember the deeper meaning of our lives and to recover our roots. Let us ask ourselves too, whether we are capable of seeing the people next door, the people who live in the same building, the people we meet each day on the street. Brothers and sisters, let us imitate the shepherds: let us learn to see! To understand by seeing with our hearts. Let us learn to see."



January 2023 has sure flown by here in the Library! We are excited for Friday January 27th to reveal the title of our **1Book5Schools** read along project!

1Book5Schools is a multi-school "book club", with families from St. Michael's School, Canyon School, Livingstone School (Lundbreck), Horace Allen (Crowsnest Pass), Isabelle Sellon (Crowsnest Pass). **About 800 families in our area will all be reading the same book at home to their children all at the same time.** We have selected a book that can be followed, understood and enjoyed by younger students, but will still captivate and stimulate older children. **The title of the book will be revealed at the kick-off assembly at St. Michael's Friday, January 27!**

Copies of the novel will be sent home with students who are the youngest K-6 student in a family.

A reading schedule will be included in the book as a bookmark, and you are asked to read it at home

January 27-February 13. No reading is scheduled for weekends, in case you need to catch up. Daily readings are about 15 minutes long. Parents are asked to read aloud at home to their children. This is valuable modelling and prepares your child to be an effective reader. This is also a fun, worthwhile family activity. More information can be found at www.readtothem.org.
