May God continue to bless St. Michael's School.




BUILD! Pilgrims of Hope - Help us build a school!



Applicants to live within the Town or M.D. of Pincher Creek and registered in an ongoing sport or activity that is led by a qualified coach or instructor.

7 or more Persons	\$116,627

TO APPLY:

Complete a KidSport Application Form and attach a copy of **one of the following** to verify your income eligibility.

- Child Health Benefit Letter
- Subsidized Housing
- Canada Child Benefit Notice
- Income Support
- · Three Consecutive Pay Stubs


